

Katy Deacon - Technical Rider

Speaker Technical Rider & Accessibility Requirements

To ensure the best possible experience for your audience and a smooth delivery for Katy's presentation, please review the following technical and accessibility requirements.

Katy is a **wheelchair user** and travels with a **Personal Assistant (PA) and Assistance Dog**. These small adjustments ensure she can focus entirely on delivering a high-impact and engaging session.

1. Stage Access

If the speaking area is raised, a compliant ramp or lift is required. If a ramp (1:12) is not available, Katy is more than happy to present from the floor level in front of the stage to maintain a close connection with the audience.

2. Audio

A lapel or headset microphone is preferred. This allows Katy to use her hands freely for manoeuvring and gesturing during her presentation.

3. Presentation Setup

If a lectern is used, please ensure there is a small, low-height table nearby for a glass of water and a clicker.

4. Confidence Monitor / Presentation View

Please ensure Katy has a view of the presentation viewer for her presentation. This could be using a monitor at the front of the stage or on a laptop next to her presenting area.

5. Presentation Slides

Katy typically presents using a standard 16:9 slide deck. Please confirm if you require the file in advance or if she can run it from her own device (HDMI connection preferred).

6. Arrival & Parking

Access to an accessible parking space near the entrance and a "step-free" route from the car park to the green room/stage is essential.

7. Audience Q&A

Katy thrives on audience engagement. If there is a Q&A session, please ensure there is a roving microphone for the audience so she can hear and interact with everyone clearly.
